This 2020 work plan seeks to make meaningful advancement on California's integrated approach to climate change while maintaining a level of flexibility given the TAC's charge, as specified in Senate Bill 246, to be responsive to timely, urgent, and critical issues. Below are the five priorities that were discussed during the last quarterly meeting of the ICARP TAC in December 2019 and then during a work group meeting of the ICARP TAC on February 6, 2020. While this work plan is subject to change over the course of the year in scope and scale, and particularly as the COVID-19 situation evolves, it gives structure and continuity to the ICARP TAC's work ahead on the identified priority areas.
