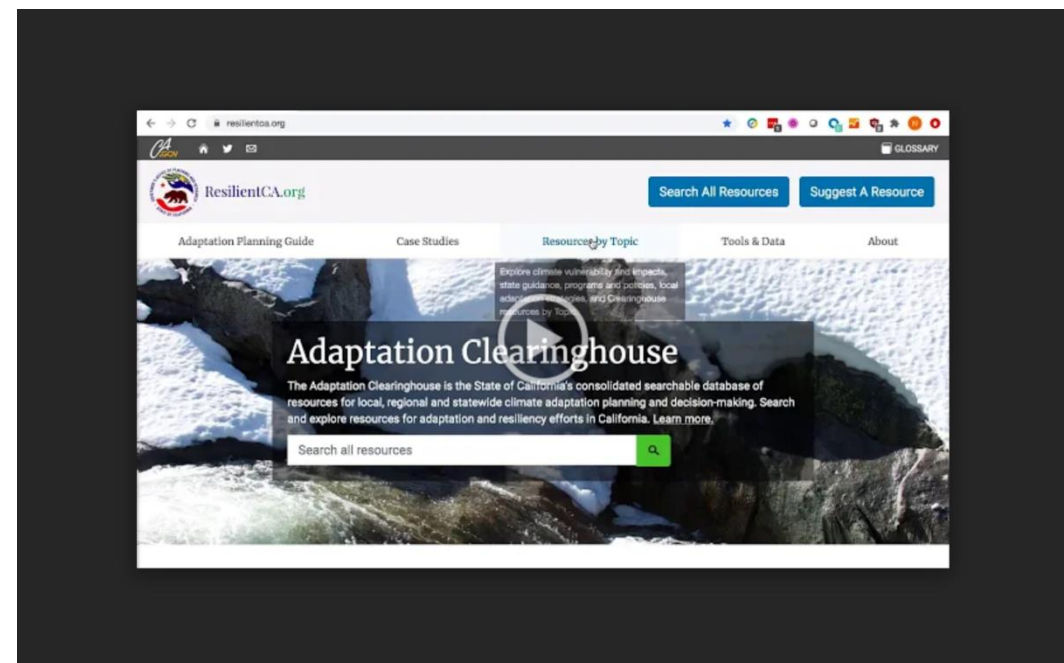

# OPR-FEMA CTP Grant Goals

---

**Goal 1:** Coordination and development of at least two flood risk mitigation pilot projects that can meet FEMA Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) eligibility requirements.

**Goal 2:** Feasibility study that explores the development and ongoing maintenance of a public-facing easily navigable local government "risk mitigation" project database for the Adaptation Clearinghouse. (Work will start in January 2021)





# OPR-FEMA CTP Grant Goal 1

---

- OPR, through ICARP, will provide technical assistance and coordination support to align Federal Hazard Mitigation Assistance funding with state programmatic resilience goals.
- Priority project types, as identified by FEMA:
  - Soil health,
