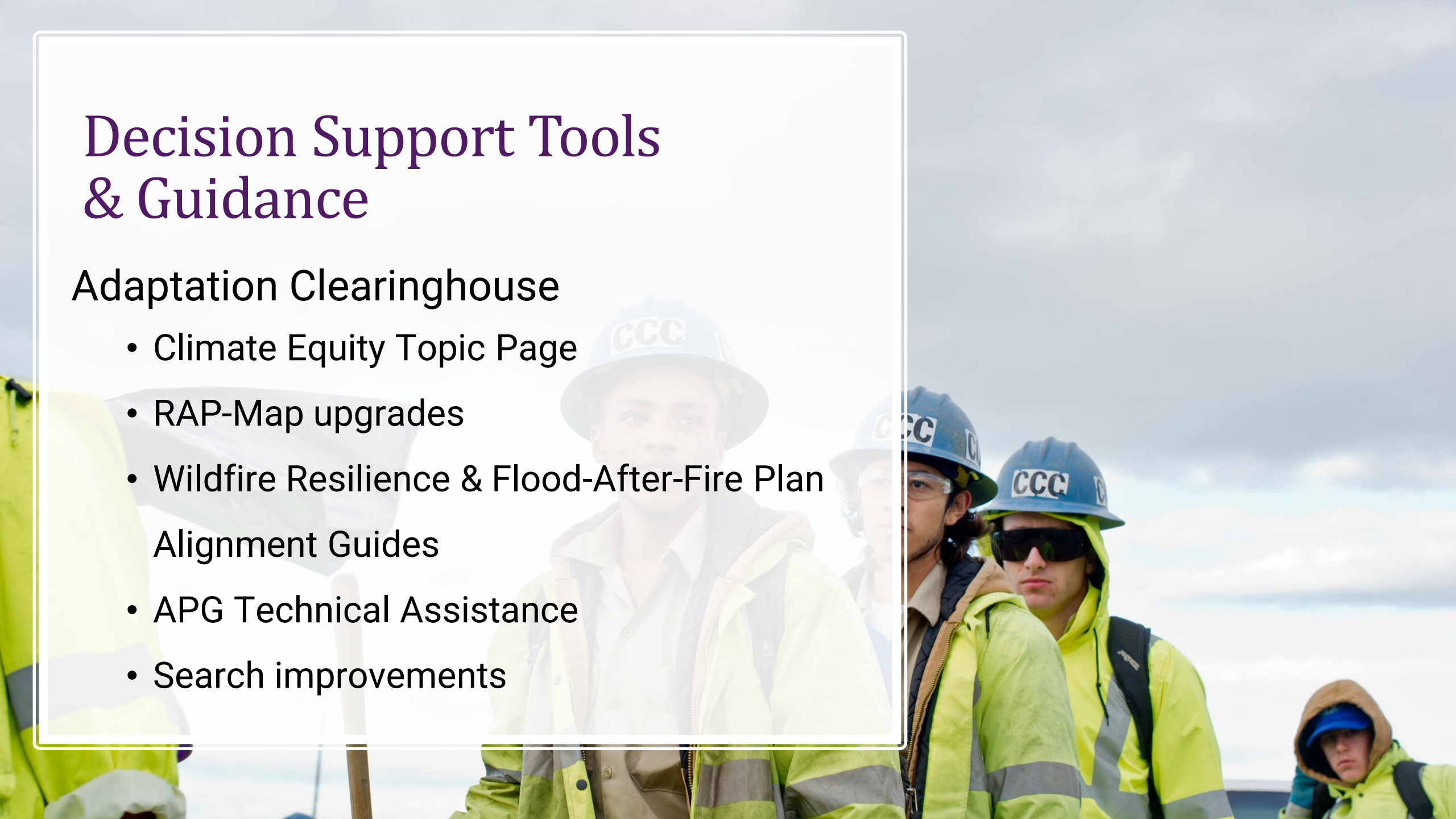

Vulnerable Communities Platform

Goal: Integrate existing datasets to deliver an **open, accessible, user-friendly and integrated platform** that **holistically identifies communities vulnerable to climate change impacts**

Process:

- Development will include **robust stakeholder process** to “ground-truth” the data
- Engagement with **ICARP Technical Advisory Council**
- Partnership with state agency partners > **interagency technical working group**
- Partnership with **ESRI** for technical support
- Partnerships with **EJ, equity and community-based organizations**
